Dear Parents, Teachers and Friends,

Last night, there were some changes announced in response of the spread of Covid in Western Australia that affect schools. Some of these changes impact parents and their interactions with school. Please note the following.

Parents are encouraged to pick up and drop off in outside environments only. Preference is made for the drop off zones at the Junior Learning Centre, the pick up and drop off zone adjacent to the oval, and the main school entrance on Johnston Street. Parents should not be visiting classrooms.

If parents are wishing to speak to staff members, a phone or online interview is expected rather than face to face.

Parents should only attend the school office in the event of a significant pastoral care or welfare issue related to their child.

The School Uniform Shop will has also changed opening hours from 2:45pm to 3:15pm till further notice.

School camps have also had to be postponed or cancelled. This includes the Year 6 camp to Geraldton, and the Year 7 camp to Coral Bay. There may be an opportunity for these camps to be held later in the year.
