



St Mary Star of the Sea Catholic School Uniform Policy Updated 2021

The school uniform identifies the individual as belonging to the whole. It should be worn neatly and correctly and with pride. All items of clothing must be **clearly marked** with the student's name.

Kindy Uniform is not compulsory but children may wear the same as for Pre-Primary

Primary – Years 2 – 6

- Girls** Blue/white checked dress **OR**
Blue Polo shirt with school logo with
Maroon sports shorts
Primary Tracksuit
All Black shoes
White crew length socks
Black Tights/Leggings
St Mary's hat or cap
All white or blue hair ties/ribbons

- Boys** Blue polo shirt with school logo
Maroon sports shorts **OR**
Grey shorts
Primary tracksuit
All Black shoes
White or grey crew socks

UNIFORMS

Secondary School—Years 7—10

- Girls** Maroon/blue check dress **OR**
Maroon Polo shirt with school logo
with Navy sports shorts
Secondary tracksuit
All Black shoes
White crew length socks
St Mary's hat or cap

- Boys** Maroon Polo Shirt with school logo.
Grey shorts **OR** Navy sports shorts
Secondary Tracksuit
All Black shoes
Grey or white crew length socks
St Mary's hat or cap

Secondary Students Year 11—12

Senior Secondary students have a separate navy blue uniform with all black shoes (other than on sports days).

UNIFORMS

Dresses must be knee length. Any shorter is not permitted.

Boxers and bike shorts/skins are not to be noticeable under shorts and dresses.

The School hat/cap is compulsory and must be worn at all times when students are outdoors. Students without a hat will be made to sit in the undercroft during recess and lunchtime, or in the shade during physical education or sport.

If students are not in uniform on a regular basis a note will be sent home which is required to be signed and returned to school. Children will be expected to make the appropriate changes in a timely manner.

JEWELLERY HAIR AND MAKE UP

No necklaces, bangles, brooches or rings. Any of these items of jewellery worn to school will be kept safely and returned to your child at the end of the school day. Only one pair of stud earrings or sleepers is permissible, to be worn in the lower lobes only. All other forms of body piercing is NOT acceptable.

Hair should be worn off the face. No hair colours. Shoulder length must be tied back. This applies to both boys and girls.

Make-up and nail varnish is not acceptable. Students will be asked to remove make-up and nail varnish. Nail extensions are also not permitted. Long nails are discouraged at school and must be taped when participating in Physical Education.
