



## St Mary Star of the Sea Catholic School Uniform Policy Updated 2019

The school uniform identifies the individual as belonging to the whole. It should be worn neatly and correctly and with pride. All items of clothing must be **clearly marked** with the student's name.

### Pre-Primary & Year One

- Girls** Blue polo shirt with school logo  
Maroon shorts  
Black shoes and/or black joggers  
White ankle socks  
Brown sandals  
St Mary's hat or cap  
Plain white or blue hair ties/ribbons
- Boys** Maroon shorts  
Blue polo shirt with school logo  
Black joggers & white or grey ankle socks or brown sandals

### Sports Uniform—Pre-Primary & Year One

- Girls** Maroon shorts  
Pale Blue polo shirt with school logo  
St Mary's tracksuit (for winter)
- Boys** Maroon shorts  
Pale Blue polo shirt with school logo  
St Mary's tracksuit (for winter)

### Primary – Years 2 – 6

- Girls** Blue/white checked dress  
Maroon tracksuit (or jacket only) (for winter)  
Black lace-up shoes and/or black joggers  
White crew length socks or navy tights (winter only)  
Brown sandals  
St Mary's hat or cap

- Boys** Blue polo shirt with school logo  
Grey shorts or trousers (*not grey cords*)  
Maroon tracksuit (or jacket only) (for winter)  
Black lace-up shoes &/or black joggers  
White or grey ankle socks  
Brown sandals  
St Mary's hat or cap



### Middle School—Years 7—10

- Girls** Maroon/blue check dress/white collar and cuffs.  
Maroon tracksuit (or jacket only) (for winter)  
Black lace-up shoes and/or joggers  
White crew length socks  
Brown sandals  
St Mary's Hat or Cap  
Plain white or blue hair ties/ribbons  
Navy tights in winter only

- Boys** Maroon Polo Shirt with school logo.  
Grey shorts or trousers (*not grey cords*)  
Maroon sports jacket (for winter)  
Black lace-up shoes and/or joggers  
Grey or white socks  
Brown Sandals  
St Mary's Hat or Cap

## Sports Uniform for Years 2 – 10

<b>Girls</b>	Maroon shorts Pale Blue polo shirt with school logo Black lace-up joggers with white crew length socks
<b>Boys</b>	Maroon shorts Pale Blue polo shirt with school logo Black lace-up joggers with white crew length socks

### PLEASE NOTE:

- **Skate and Ballet shoes are not permitted due to Health and Safety**
- **Socks are to be above the ankle, but not knee high.**
- **Dresses are to have zippers done up to the top—not partially down.**
- **Dresses must be knee length. Any shorter is not permitted.**
- **Boxers and shorts are not to be noticeable under shorts and dresses. Bike Pants are permitted under dresses**
- **Polo shirts must have at least 2 buttons done up**
- **Any shoulder length hair must be tied back and off the face**
- **No Roman style sandals.**

**The School hat/cap is compulsory and must be worn at all times when students are outdoors. Students without a hat will be made to sit in the undercroft during recess and lunchtime, or in the shade during physical education or sport.**

### Jewellery, Hair and Make-up

- **No necklaces, bangles, brooches or rings.** Any of these items of jewellery worn to school will be confiscated and kept for the remainder of the term. Only **one pair of stud earrings or sleepers** is permissible, to be worn in the lower lobes only. All other forms of body piercing is **NOT** acceptable.
- Hair should be worn off the face. **No hair colours.** Shoulder length must be tied back. This applies to both **boys** and **girls.** Ribbons/hair ties must be white or blue.
- **Make-up and nail varnish is out place with school uniform and is not acceptable. Students will be asked to remove make-up and nail varnish.** Nail extensions are also not permitted. Long nails are discouraged at school and must be taped when participating in Physical Education.

### **MOBILE PHONE POLICY:-**

Students are not to bring mobile telephones on to the school site. If a child brings their phone to school they must hand them in to the front office and collect at the end of the day. If a student is found to be in possession of a mobile telephone their phone will be confiscated. The parent of the student will be notified and the parent will need to collect the mobile phone from the Front Office

Where there are extraordinary circumstances the parent must make an appointment with the Heads of School or the Principal to discuss the situation

The school will not accept any responsibility for the theft, loss or damage of any mobile telephone brought on to the school site by a student.
